Technical Details

- Professional-grade digital voice recorder
- Record up to 138 hours of digital audio
- 512 MB of internal flash memory
- Can be used as a USB mass storage device
- Convenient USB 2.0 direct design for fast data transfer (**very important**)

Its most practical feature is the size. It is less than half the size of most cell phones and can record crisp audio through clothing. **Average Customer Review: 4.6 Stars out of 5 Stars.**
